At times of the Oktoberfest he can hence see as far as the Theresienwiese, where the Munich breweries have their beer halls. 

Stories surrounding the Oktoberfest

On occasion of the wedding of crown prince Ludwig and princess Therese on the 12th October 1810 numerous private and public celebrations were held. The last of these celebrations, the horse race on the 17th of October, is the origin of the Oktoberfest.

From 1814 on, the festival was growing every year. Climbing trees, bowling lanes and swings were added to the racecourse. In 1818 the first merry-go-round was set up. Multiple raffle booths attracted predominantly the poorer citizens, as china, silver and jewellery could be won. In 1819 the Munich city fathers became directors of the festival. From then on, it should become a scheduled annual event.



On the Oktoberfest, many a man has not only lost his heart, but also his head. The 'Schichtl', named after its founder Michael August Schichtl (1851-1911), has been an inherent part of the Oktoberfest since 1869. Magic and curiosities are presented here. The Schichtl became famous for the beheading of a living person by guillotine, which is shown until today. So far more than 9000 spectators have been beheaded.

Who however prefers to keep his head, has the biggest choice of modern rides and pleasures of all kinds at the Oktoberfest.

Today the Oktoberfest, or the Wiesn (meadow) as we say in Bavaria, is the biggest fair in the world and attracts about 6 mio. visitors per year, of which statistically everyone drinks a 'Maß' (1 litre stein). An experienced tapster only needs 1.5 seconds to fill a stein!
